In English, we will start the term with a unit on non-fiction with a focus on comprehension and explanation writing. One of our key areas for development within school is vocabulary enrichment so pupils will be working in teams to show their skills in manipulating language and learning lots of new words! In maths, we will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages whilst continuing to develop knowledge and recall of key facts. In computing, we will focus on creating and using spreadsheets for a variety of purposes.
